WHAT IS A GROCERY STORY?

- Individual stories shared by Nashville residents that describe unique experiences of buying groceries.

WHY ARE WE COLLECTING GROCERY STORIES?

- We are working with the idea that from many voices comes one story. These stories will help us make the case for the need for equitable access to affordable healthy food for all of Nashville's residents. We will post Grocery Stories to our website: www.restoringnashville.org. You can post stories directly to the website.

HOW DO I GET SOMEONE TO TELL ME THEIR GROCERY STORY?

- Have them sign and date the release, and either help guide them through the form or suggest the questions below.
- Ask questions: We want to hear your story about a memorable trip (or just your last one) to the grocery store. What were you buying? Was it for a special event? Did you find what you were looking for? Were you happy with the product (was it fresh and of good quality)? How long did it take you to get to the store? Did you walk, bike, bus, drive or take a cab? Did a friend, family member or neighbor take you to the store? Do you have to go out of your way to shop for food? Is your grocery store in a neighborhood different than where you live?
We want details!
